Nokonoshima, a beautiful island floating in the middle of Hakata Bay.

This small island with its 12km coastline and abundant nature is blessed with the romance of history. That heritage includes monuments to the Manyoshu literature of the Nara Period (7th Century), and the ruins of a deer hunting wall constructed during the feudal reign of the Kuroda clan. The well-known writer Dan Kazuo claimed Noko as his spiritual homeland by spending his last years here. And the obscure song of the famous singer Inoue Yosui, 'Unrequited love of Nokonoshima', captures the bitterness of a young broken heart. Please enjoy a relaxed time here on the island that has never known the urban haste of modern life.

Island Sights

Manyoshu Monuments

There are two monuments commemorating the mention of Nokonoshima in the Manyoshu. One monument features an extract from one of the ten Chikuzen waka poems, and the other quotation is from an ancient Korean messenger, writing in China.

Dan Kazuo Monument

This monument acknowledges the nationally respected author Dan Kazuo who spent the final years of his life here on Noko. The inscription is a Dan Kazuo quotation from the last poem he composed on his death bed: The flute of the winter wind rattles bamboo, night after night, onwards to the flowers.

Nokonoshima Bayside Beach

During the April-September season, the pontoon moored offshore, with its marine trampoline, sees plenty of action. Kids love the banana-boat rides and holiday groups rent shoreline bungalows.

Nature Trail, Contemplation Forest

This is the perfect path for cycling around the island, right through the untouched areas that feature interesting seasonal flowers and fruits.

Nokonoshima Observatory

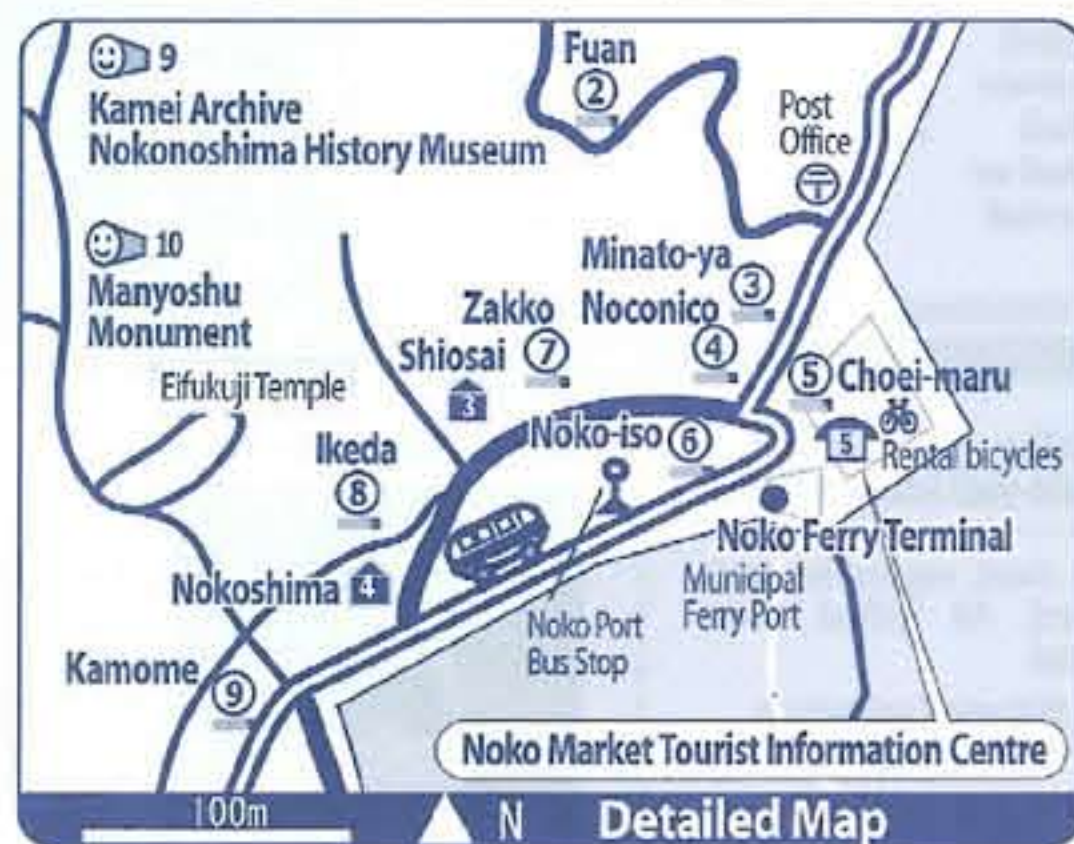
Located 195 metres above the blue of Hakata Bay, the panorama from this Observatory takes in the whole island of Noko, the surrounding ocean and the distant Fukuoka shoreline. There is a place to rest. No charges apply.

Nokonoshima Yume Coffee Garden

Stroll around tropical plants at this garden cafe. Entry adults 500 yen, children 300 yen. (price includes a cup of coffee brewed from beans grown on-site here)
Regular holidays: TUE, WED, THU (except GW and the autumn season)

Kamei Archive Nokonoshima History Museum

Permanent exhibitions feature the local folk customs of Nokonoshima, and planned shows are held for limited periods. Closed from December 1st until the end of February. Entry adults 400 yen, middle and high school students admitted without charge.
From March to November: only Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays are open
